- Overview of Meeting Process
  - Bylaws Committee will present the by-laws
  - Initial review will be only to remove suggested edits made by the committee
  - Once all suggested edits are either approved or rejected, then the floor will be open to edits from elected PCO's
- Overview of Election Process
  - Candidate must be nominated and accept nomination
  - In the event of only one (1) person nominated move to elect by acclamation
  - In the event of two (2) or more candidates running for each position:
    - Candidates speak in order of nomination
    - Each candidate may speak for no more than two (2) minutes
    - Election will be decided by signed ballot
    - The candidate with over 50% + 1 of the vote wins
    - In the event no candidate breaches the threshold, the lowest vote getter will be dropped and another election will proceed until one (1) candidate secures 50% +1 of the vote
    - Each candidate may appoint one (1) tally committee watcher to overview committee as they are counting their race
    - Only elected PCO's may vote on Chair, Vice Chair, and the two (2) State Committee Reps, all other voting rights for officers are as defined by the by-laws and will be referred to before each election.
